The Ankeny Community Band was founded in 2004 shortly after the opening of the Bandshell in Wagner Park. The band has now grown to approximately 50 musicians and performs six concerts per season beginning with Memorial Day and ending in late July. Director responsibilities are shared by local music education professionals Joel Poppen and Jayson Gerth. The band strives to provide an informal venue for adults who want to continue to play their instrument after high school or college, while providing high-quality free band concerts to the community. The material played by the band follows the time-honored tradition of many community bands throughout the state of Iowa playing marches, show tunes, and other popular band literature.

The band is supported with grants from the Polk County Board of Supervisors, and Bravo of Greater Des Moines. In addition, the band receives support from the Ankeny Community Schools with the use of its band room and equipment, and from the City of Ankeny for the use of its Bandshell. Without the support of these partners the band could not exist.
